manufactured or "substantially transformed" in the United States or a TAA "designated country". The designated countries are composed of:

- World Trade Organization Government Procurement Agreement Countries;
- Free Trade Agreement Countries;
- Least Developed Countries; and
- **Caribbean Basin Countries**

A challenging aspect of the Trade Agreements Act (TAA) for US-based manufacturers is maintaining costs in a competitive and dynamic global market, against the backdrop of a complex global supply chain. CyberData, in business since 1974 and based in Monterey, CA, complies with the terms of TAA and certifies that each end product\* is a US-made or a designated country end product, as defined in the Federal Acquisition Regulation clause 52.225-5 entitled "Trade Agreements."

GSA (General Services Administration) Schedule contracts, and most DOD (Department of Defense) contracts all have TAA compliance requirements as part of their federal procurement process. In accordance with TAA, only US-made or Schedule designated country end products shall be offered and sold under Schedule contracts.
