
Typical System Installation







Dimensions (Rear View and Mounting Holes)

RTFM Button




When the device is operational and linked to a network, you can use the Reset Test Function Management (RTFM) button (SW1 [see picture]) to restore the device to the factory default settings.

To restore the device to factory default settings:

 Press and hold the RTFM button for longer than five seconds.

Note The device will use DHCP to obtain the new IP address (DHCP-assigned address or default to 10.10.10.10 if a DHCP server is not present).
