



Setting up your webcam



Positioning on a monitor

Grasp the webcam in one hand and open the flexible clip base with your other hand. Mount the webcam onto the top of the monitor, making sure that the foot on the flexible clip base is flush with the back of the monitor.


Using your webcam

Optimal Performance

- · Do not sit in front of a window or other bright light source
- Having an uncluttered background will will have your viewers concentrating on you
- The mounting system allows for tilting and aiming the camera. While sitting in your normal position, your entire face should be just above the middle of the picture. Tilt and move the camera to frame up a good view.
