HOW TO MUTE/ANSWER/HANG UP CALLS:

Mute and Unmute the microphone by simply tapping the MUTE button, the logo will turn red and you will hear a short beep.

To **answer and end** a call press the **c** button, it will turn green to show a call is active. Press again to hang up the call.

- To avoid hearing damage, do not use this product with high volume for prolonged period.

CONNECTING THE HEADSET TO PC:

When the headset is connected to USB for the first time a pop-up message will be shown in the taskbar, telling you that the headset is connected and ready.

OPERATING THE HEADSET:

When the headset is connected to a PC, while not on calls, the user is able to listen to music or another audio source.

WEARING THE HEADSET:

All Sangoma corded headsets have a flexible and adjustable headband. Place the headband on your head with the headset on your ear, and adjust the headband for a comfortable fit






CALL CONTROL UNIT: The HC100 Call Control Unit has 4 keys.

ROTATING THE BENDABLE BOOM ARM:

NOTE: For optimal sound quality, adjust the bendable boom arm until it is right in front of your mouth and less than 3-4 cm (1.25" -1.5") away.

The boom arm can be rotated 270°
